

Fellow road users: On March 21st, 2017 Ohio's 3 Foot Passing Law for bicycles goes into effect. Simply put, you must give bicyclists that you pass at least 3 feet of space while overtaking them on the road. Public roads are to be safe for all users, and we thank you for being considerate to those on 2 wheels that you encounter.

"The operator of a vehicle overtaking another vehicle shall pass to the left at a safe distance and shall not again drive to the right until safely clear of the overtaken vehicle. When a motor vehicle overtakes and passes a bicycle, three feet or greater is considered a safe passing distance."
