What: The purpose of this meeting is to present information regarding the construction of the Pearl Road Rehabilitation Project. The work includes street rehabilitation; replacement of curb, sidewalks and driveway aprons as needed; ADA compliant ramps; non-standard catch basins will be removed and replaced; bicycle facilities will be installed streetscape will be installed between State Rd. and Wildlife Way; a new watermain will be installed; and traffic signals upgraded. The project will begin February 2016 and is scheduled to be completed December 2017.
